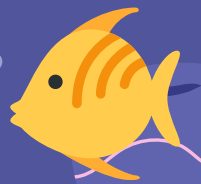


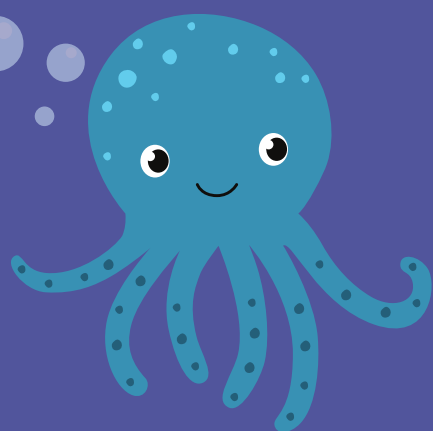
SLIPPERY FISH

A Fun Friday Music and Movement Activity!



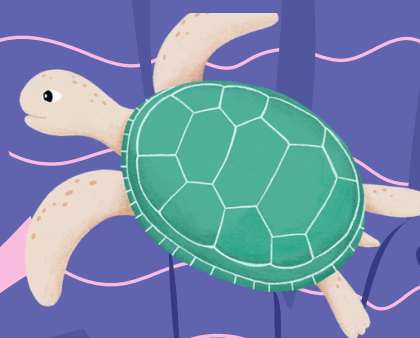
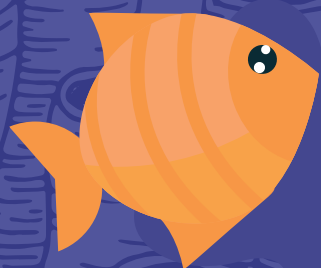
HOW TO DO IT:

Click the [YouTube link here](#) to access a video that demonstrates the movements alongside the song. When searching for the video on YouTube, look for this thumbnail

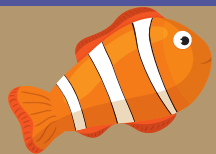


Each verse will bring about a different sea creature that swims in the water, and then gets eaten by an even bigger creature!

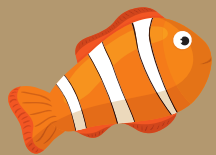
Kids can follow along with the movements shown in the video. Grown-ups can help by doing the movements as well for the kids to copy!



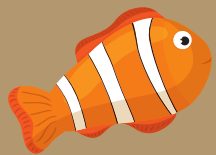
