


Throughout presentation notes, **BOLD** is for the coach only to read, *italics* is a script for coach to read to caregiver.

This presentation will allow you to check in with caregivers to make sure they were able to successfully download the App and set up their profile. It will walk them through the flow of the App to give them a better idea of how they will be using it.

This should be about 30 min long


*First, I'm going to check-in with you about how set up went to see if you have any questions about what you filled out for [CHILD'S] profile.* 

Then, we'll review ABC data collection. It sounds a little intimidating but it's really just a way of breaking things down to figure out what's going on in [CHILD'S] world when he/she has challenging behavior. Why might this be happening? Once we understand that, we can figure out what to do about it.

Then we'll practice collecting data together with a video of [CHILD] from one of the practice sessions.

Then I'm going to have you try one out on your own and practice putting it into the app. I'll be here to guide you along in case you have questions or don't understand something as it comes up.

And last we'll schedule our next meeting and talk about what you need to do in the meantime.





Did you run into any issues or questions about entering information for your profile? As a reminder, all of this information is optional, only enter what you feel comfortable sharing with us. This information is just to help the research team adapt to better help more families.



These three parts of the App (universal strategies, ABC data collection and hypothesis, and BSP) work in a cyclical manner. This is a continuous process, and we will be using information from each section to inform any of the other sections.

We will get into ABC data collection in detail in the next presentation, but just so you are aware, you can only enter 1 instance of CB per day, and once you get 5 instances entered your hypothesis will be generated for you to confirm or deny. If you deny the hypothesis, you will be asked to enter more data. Once the hypothesis is confirmed, your BSP will be created!



The universal strategies section starts with a screen that looks like this. Right now, you will only have access to the self-love button.

When you click self-love, it will take you to a screen that describes the purpose of self-love and provides links to resources.

The next screen will allow you to enter some of your own information about self-love. Each of the strategies are set up in the same way in the App, where you have a screen that explains the purpose and provides resource links, and then opportunities to put the strategies into practice and enter some info.

You'll notice at the bottom of the self-entry page, it will ask you if you want to share [child's name]'s progress with any of the individuals you listed. If you select yes, it will take you to the page on the next slide.

After you enter your self-love info, it will take you to this screen where you can add anyone to your account. Whoever you add will be able to see all of your data, and you can add or delete people at any time.
