# PUMPKIN PLAY DOUGH





# SUPPLIES

3 CUP FLOUR  
2 TBSP CREAM OF TARTAR  
1 CUP SALT  
3 TBSP OIL  
3 CUP WATER  
2 TSP CINNAMON OR  
PUMPKIN PIE SPICE  
RED (8-10 DROPS) & YELLOW  
(5-7) FOOD COLORING

## HOW TO DO IT:

1. COMBINE DRY INGREDIENTS IN SAUCEPAN AND MIX.
2. THEN ADD WATER AND STIR OVER MEDIUM HEAT.
3. STIR UNTIL DOUGH PULLS AWAY FROM THE SIDES OF THE PAN.
4. LET COOL. ONCE COOL SQUISH AND KNEED LUMPS OUT. STORE IN AIRTIGHT CONTAINER TO SAVE!
