INFORMATION ABOUT HOW
THEIR CHILD IS DOING AT
HOME.

PUTTING IT INTO PRACTICE

POSITIVE PRACTITIONER FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS

- TRY TO BUILD TRUST AND RESPECT IN EVERY INTERACTIONS WITH FAMILIES
- CONSIDER LOOKING AT SITUATIONS FROM THE PARENTS' VIEWPOINT
- USE EFFECTIVE LISTENING SKILLS
 WHEN TALKING WITH FAMILIES
 (EMPATHY, SINCERITY,
 RESPONSIVENESS)
- BE RESPONSIVE TO EACH FAMILY'S PERSONAL AND CULTURAL BELIEFS



- HELP PARENTS DETERMINE WHAT THIER GOALS ARE FROM WORKING WITH YOU
- GIVE PARENTS POSITIVE FEEDBACK AND ENCORUAGEMENT THROUGHOUT THE PROCESS
- OFFER MULTIPLE IDEAS AND SUGGESTIONS FOR FAMILIES TO CONSIDER
